#### **Bulletin Board**

- Bulletin Board Titles are 8.5" wide.
- After printing, cut the tiles by hand or laminate first, then cut.
- Some titles can serve as permanent fixtures on your bulletin board, while others may be used occasionally for specific purposes.

#### 48-Week Quotes

- 1. Print out 24 pages.
- 2. Consider using different colors of paper to add visual interest.
- 3. Stack the pages evenly and cut them in half horizontally using a large paper cutter or scissors (if cutting by hand, work in small batches for accuracy).
- 4. Update your quote weekly to draw consistent attention to your bulletin board, both from the person maintaining it and from passersby.
